

A lot has happened and is happening in the Archery world at JCOC. Winter leagues for 2017 went real well. We had an increase of shooters over last year with the addition of animal leagues. Both spot and animal leagues had 6 to 10 shooters weekly. At the end of leagues, in lieu of trophies, we gave all shooters a JCOC t-shirt. We also had a real nice

dinner & a shoot off. I chipped in \$25 for a shoot off prize and it was won by one of our youngest shooters, Austin Bowers. Jim Moore donated his time and fish for a great walleye and onion deep fry dinner. We will be offering leagues again in 2018 to include spot, animal, and new for 2018 a class/league for beginning to intermediate shooters,

ages 7-14, taught by Jim Moore and Norm Zakazewski. Leagues will begin in January and run to early March 2018. 3D is off to a great start this year. We had 4 shoots already, and have 2 more in September on the 10th and 24th. 2014 netted 75 3-D shooters, 2015 had 67, 2016 had 146, and so far this year we have had 126 shooters with 2 shoots left.

Our numbers are increasing and I'm sure will even get better. Our board approved a \$4300 investment for targets and repair kits in April. We had 14 brandnew Mckensie/Delta 3-D tournament targets for our March shoot. These needed to be replaced, because the majority of the targets we had were pur-

chased in '88 and '89 were in bad shape. Hopefully our shooter numbers will increase enough to warrant the purchase of more new targets, so I can entice national archery organizations to hold their shoots at our club. The older targets can then be used at the same time to set up other mon-

ey-making competitions. We are also still working on making improvements on the course. We still need more bowholders on about 1/2 the 3-D course. We have been able to change targets around and set up new shots because of the purchase, and that keeps interest up with the shooters.


