News from the President

Another opening day of gun deer season is in the book. I observed three deer on opening day, a four point and a doe at ten yards, likely a brother and sister. Also, a large doe. At seventy-six I do not hunt as much as I did in years past, but I can still climb onto a tree stand. Thanksgiving has passed and on December 2nd the club will be hosting Annual Night. There will be drawings for prizes and a state licensed raffle for a Henry .44 caliber single shot rifle. At our regular membership meeting on January 2nd, 2024 we will discuss administration of the new gate to the boat launch. The gate will not be locked until January 1, 2024. After that date "anyone" seeking access to the boat launch will need the lock combination. Members will see the range gate lock combination and the boat launch gate combination on their 2024 membership cards. The combinations are changed each year on January first, so get those renewals in to receive the new combinations. they purchase a boat sticker, <u>**OR**</u> the board may determine a set period (e.g. April-May) when the gate will not be locked and access to the boat launch will be permitted.

The water tests negative for bacteria at all spigots except the kitchen spigot. Hopefully, the decontamination on Monday will resolve that issue. Board Meeting Notes

The November Membership and Board meetings were held at the clubhouse on Tuesday, November 7th with 32 members present. The following actions were discussed and/or taken:



- Three new members were introduced and approved.
- It was reported that all mowing equipment has been tuned-up for next spring. A gate is being installed at the boat launch which will have a lock. Renewing members will receive the code.
- The pistol range saw 76 signed in users and the rifle range saw 101 signed in users. 15 guests were registered, however only \$30 was in the range box. The same guest is allowed 3 times per year at \$5.00 each visit.
- The outside light wiring has been replaced at the modular rental.
- A coalition has been established, The Coalition to Protect Michigan's Resources (CPMR), a sport fishing organization focused on protecting the fishery in the Great Lakes, filed an appeal opposing entry of the 2023 Great Lakes Consent Decree in the Sixth Circuit Court of Appeals regarding gillnetting. - Officer/Directors elections were held and are listed in the President's News.

Owl Prowl Night Hike will start at 6:30 pm Thursday, December 28th with a short indoor presentation to learn about the owl species that reside in Michigan, their adaptations, and then we'll take a night hike on Dahlem's quiet trails listening for owls and other night creatures.

We will use an artificial device to call out to owls with anticipation that they answer back. In past, the Great Horned, Barred and Screech owls have replied. This is a fun night not to be missed.

The program is appropriate for ages 12 years and older. Children must be accompanied by an adult that is registered for this program.

Tree Sale Preview 2024

The Jackson County Conservation District's Spring Tree Sale fundraiser will take place in 2024 on April 12-13 at Keeley Park. This is a pre-order event and catalogs will go out in mid-January. All trees were pre-ordered, so there is a limited sup-ply! Order early!

This year JCCD will be offering conifer seedlings (White and Red Pine, Norway Spruce, Douglas Fir, White Cedar and American Larch), and conifer transplants (White, Norway and Blue Spruce, White Pine and Fraser Fir). Also offered will be Allegheny Serviceberry, Highbush Cranberry, White Birch, Paw Paw, Pin Oak, Quaking Aspen, Red Maple, Eastern Redbud, Red Osier Dogwood, Speckled Alder, Swamp White Oak and American Sycamore. Deer food and pollinator packs, Albion Strawberries, Bluecrop Blueberries, Mammoth Red Raspberries, Jersey Knight Asparagus, as well as apple, pear, peach and cherry trees will also be included.
