The May Membership and Board meeting were held at the clubhouse on Tuesday, May 7th with 24 members present. The following actions were discussed and/or taken:



- 9 new members were welcomed and approved.

- The April S3DA archery shoot had 71 shooters and a net income of \$730.
 \$50 was turned in from the Archery box. The May 4/5 ASA Tri-State Archery shoot had 89 participants with a net income of \$1,422.
- The rifle/pistol ranges were accessed 51 times and \$55 was turned in from the gun box.
- JCOC has 308 adult members to date.
- Rental properties are up to date. Work needs to be done on the trailer shed.
- \$845 was turned in from lake residents who purchased boat stickers.





Be sure to use the far left trap house nearest the railroad bed. A DANGER exits if people are using the mentioned ranges and during trap shooting you shoot into the area. Thank you.

A reminder to sign in at the gate before entering the club grounds!! This allows members entering to be aware of where other members are on the property. Also remember to have your membership card with you. This is for safety purposes!!

A reminder that the speed limit is 15 mph on the entrance and exit roads to JCOC. This is a private drive which we share with several other neighbors.
