Trap Range

The Trap Range will be opening Wednesday nights beginning Wednesday, June 17th and continues through the last Wednesday in October. There are two trap machines and shooting areas. Shooting begins at 5:00 PM and continues until everyone has shot as many rounds as they wish. Charges are \$5 for non-members, \$4 for members and \$3 for youth under age 18 for a round consisting of 25 clay pigeons. Shells are not included or sold at the club.



The trap machines are not available to members, except on Wednesdays at the nightly shoot. However, you may bring a hand thrower or portable trap machine of your own and use it at the trap area. Please check to make certain there are no 3D, rifle or pistol target shooters using those ranges before you shoot at the trap range. Those areas are directly North of the trap ranges and in the line of fire.

Boat Launch

All members using our boat launch are asked to request a "free" sticker for their boat(s), skidoo(s), or pontoon. Send your request by email to Randy at rjvgolf@gmail.com include your address and membership number. This is new this year and we hope to be able to identify unauthorized people using our launch. If you do not request a sticker do not be surprised if someone asks to see your membership card. Not mandatory, but helpful.
